- Encourage your child to learn the rules of their code of conduct and plays within them.
- Discourage your child from arguing with officials, volunteers and Coaches
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performance of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept the official's judgements.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times
- Encourage and Guide performers to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
- Ensure that your child is wearing appropriate clothing and footwear at all times
